

HOLMES COMMUNITY COLLEGE CHEERLEADER CONTRACT

Following are the policies and procedures for all Holmes Community College cheerleaders and mascots. Any infraction of these rules will result in a deduction of scholarship and/or the immediate dismissal from the HCC Cheerleading Squad:

HOLMES COMMUNITY COLLEGE CHEERLEADERS MUST:

- 1) Maintain a 2.00 GPA each semester.
- 2) Maintain a minimum of 12 semester hours.
- 3) Have a POSITIVE ATTITUDE at all times.
- 4) Agree to a one (1) year commitment serving both semesters for football and basketball seasons.
- 5) Agree that cheerleading is a major personal commitment of your non-academic time and that it will come first, above all other extra-curricular activities.
- 6) Be a representative of Holmes Community College, its students, faculty, staff, and alumni at all times. Therefore, always conduct yourself in a manner that will uphold the character, tradition, integrity, and spirit of HCC. Any student on disciplinary probation will not be allowed to serve.
- 7) Be physically fit.
- 8) Never drink, smoke, dip, or use profanity while wearing any HCC garment.
- 9) Cheerfully accept all responsibilities assigned to them by the coach or head cheerleader(s).
- 10) Cheerfully follow the decisions of the coach, head cheerleader, or squad concerning all facets of squad activity. Bad attitudes will not be tolerated!
- 11) Accept responsibility for your uniform and equipment and agree to replace any part that is lost, stolen, or damaged. You will not wear any portion of your uniform on campus, at home, or anywhere other than official cheerleading events. If any part of your uniform needs to be altered or repaired during the season, it is your responsibility to have it taken care of immediately.
- 12) Always travel to and from events together.
- 13) Attend ALL practices and performances and always be on time. Following is a list of infractions and the resulting scholarship deduction:

Missing practice	\$ 25.00	Excused absences will be for:
Missing a performance	\$100.00	1) An official doctor's excuse prohibiting you from participation
1-15 minutes late	\$ 12.50	2) Death in the immediate family
More than 15 minutes late	\$ 25.00
